


Our church family welcomed in 2018 with a wonderful **New Year's Eve Party** on December 31.



# Our History Corner...

This month we revisit our church before the building we enjoy today. From 1887 until the early 1960's, our church was located at the corner of N. Michigan and James Street (currently home to an apartment building). Some of our current members who are now grandparents or great grandparents were baptized and went to Sunday School there when they were young children.

Do you see the bell in the tower? It's the very same one that we ring here every Sunday. Our bulletin lists the "Ringing of the 1887 Bell." That bell was saved, restored, and used



again when our current bell tower was added in 1989.
